

Changes to our Chew Valley School route C371G serving Temple Cloud, Hinton Blewett and Chew Valley Lakeside from 13th April 2015.

As a result of contract changes at B&NES, many home to school services have been provided by different companies since the Easter break. In order to try and retain our route, we made a proposal to the council to operate the route in a more flexible manner, recognising the requirements of the many Year 12 and 13 students who travel on it.

From September 2015, we will introduce a new arrangement for students who are not entitled to free travel passes from the council. Rather than buying passes from the council, it will now be possible to buy them on the bus or online. It will also be possible to pay a fare for single journeys without subscribing to travel for a whole term. This will offer more flexibility for students who may not be travelling all the time.

The new service will also be available from all bus stops along the route, therefore any Sixth Form students from Coley and The Harptrees will be welcome to use the service, as well as all the current stops.

There will be no change to arrangements for students who are issued entitled travel passes by B&NES. These will continue to be issued and accepted as current.

From September, the route will operate as bus service 144.

Fares for students without B&NES passes from September will be:

Single journey: £2	Six journeys: £10
Term pass: £50	Annual pass: £250

All tickets can be bought on the bus.

Cheques (payable to "Citistar Limited") are accepted for term and annual passes.

Service 144 operates Monday to Friday when Chew Valley School is in normal session.

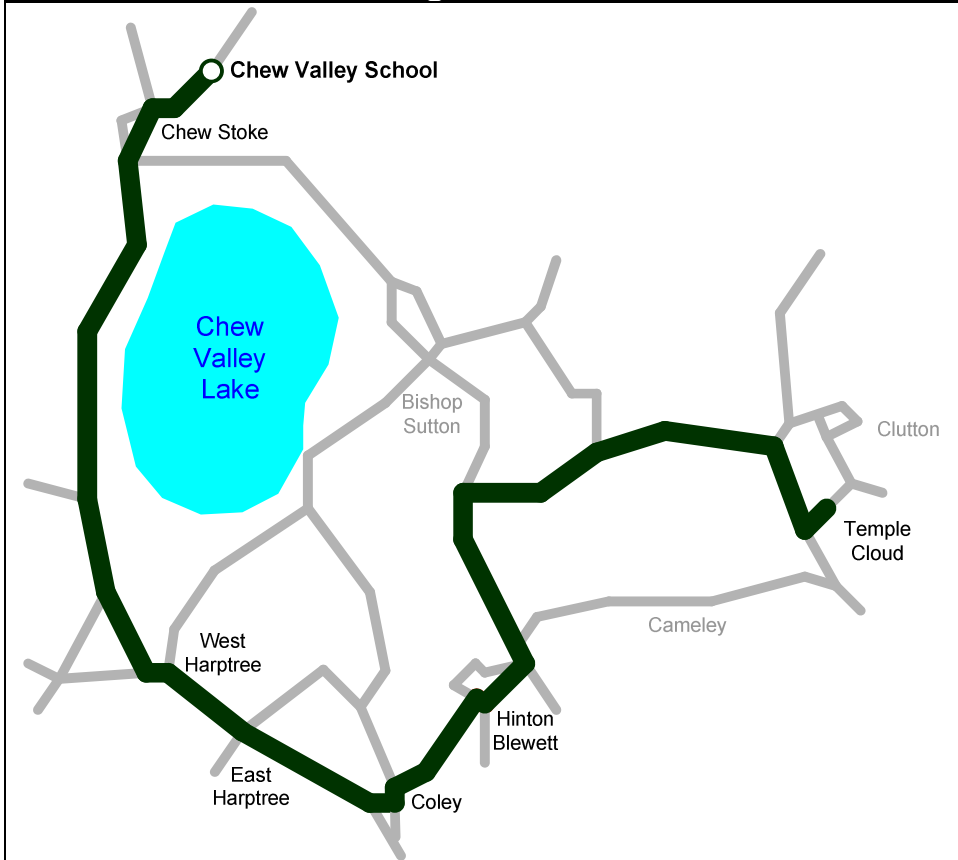
